# SAFETY PLAN

Please wash your hands regularly and take advantage of the sanitation stations located throughout the building.



Thanks to our incredible cleaning team, this building, including all handles, surfaces and kids' areas are cleaned and disinfected weekly to ensure a safe environment for everyone in attendance.



We will be opening the building Sunday, **5<sup>th</sup> July** for multiple services and will maintain a capacity in-line with advised social distancing measures through each Phase of Ireland's gradual reopening plan (*the first Sundays ages 12+ only*).



We will be serving tea and coffee in paper cups at the close of our service. There will be a one-way system to collect your beverage and abide by appropriate social distancing.



We will be offering Kids Church at a date to be announced. At that time we will continue to offer a clean and safe environment for all kids and teachers. (*All ages welcomed back*)



You don't know everyone's story, medical history, or comfort level, so please respect others' space during this time so that we can continue to create a sanctuary for everyone.
